THIS "BURN APPLICATION" SIGNIFIES THAT THE SIGNING PARTY AGREES TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

The requesting individual will have prior approval from the Stonewall Fire Protection District (SFPD) to conduct controlled outside burning of grass, brush, tree trimmings, burn barrels and combustible debris, **not to include** rubber, oils, asphalt, plastics or any other similar or hazardous material. The landowner conducting the burn is fully responsible for all actions, damages, or escaped fire. The landowner shall reimburse cost of fire suppression of an escaped fire as invoiced by the fire department.

The individual conducting the burn is responsible for contacting SFPD prior to the burn to get a specific burn permit number for *each* burn.

A burn permit may not be issued because of adverse weather conditions or state and county burn restrictions.

At no time shall the burn be left unattended. Burning shall be supervised by one or more responsible persons depending on the type of burning. Precautions shall be taken to localize the burning and in no way constitute a fire hazard to persons or property within or adjacent of the area of burning. The granting authority and the employees or agents thereof, in the issuing of a permit, do not assume any responsibility or results in damage to the person or property of the permitted, or the person or property of any third person.

The fire must be completely extinguished with water/extinguishing agent before leaving the scene.
